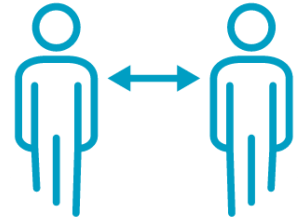




Our community has been through a lot over the last few months, and all of us are looking forward to resuming our normal habits and routines. While many things have changed, one thing has remained the same: **our commitment to your safety.**

- **How we are asking you to help us:**

- When you arrive for your appointment, we will kindly ask you to text or call us to let us know that you have arrived and then wait in your car for us to call or text you to let you know that we are ready to seat you.
- Since our office is small and a 6 foot distance from others is often difficult to maintain, you may be provided a mask and asked to wear it whenever you are not actively receiving dental care
- Please use the hand sanitizer we have provided. If you are allergic please use the restroom and wash your hands with soap.
- If using the restroom or exiting and re-entering our office, we ask that you use the hand sanitizer provided upon re-entry.
- We ask that you refrain from physical contact with others as much as possible (handshakes, hugs, etc)
- We encourage our patients to cough + sneeze into their elbow



- **Steps we are taking to ensure your safety**

- We will allow greater time between patient appointments to reduce the number of patients in the reception area at any one time.
- Our office will ask screening questions prior to providing your dental care.
- We will continue to use hospital-grade disinfectants on our surfaces, chairs, and around the office per OSHA protocol
- Our team will be wearing new forms of personal protective equipment in addition to or instead of our standard personal protective equipment.
- We will be utilizing multiple forms of high-speed evacuation during any procedure that may generate aerosols
- We will be utilizing Medical Grade HEPA air purifiers in each of our operatories that are capable of 99.97% particle removal from the air in 15 minutes
- We will not be providing magazines, children's toys, and similar items in the waiting room
- We will be using contactless forms of payment whenever possible
- We will be using electronic forms in an effort to eliminate paper forms
